
From the front door of the Barn Annexe, Wales: a short circular walk (40 mins)



This short circular walk will take you from the front door of the Barn Annexe onto the common land on Cefn Llwydallt, the hill above the Barn Annexe. Waterproof boots or shoes are a good idea.

Leave the Barn Annexe and cross, past the Barn and Nissen hut, to the gate. Go through this (please close it behind you) and bear right, going slightly downhill. You'll have to cross a wet area. Head uphill and keep to the left, parallel to the field boundary. You'll come to a gate which leads onto the common land. Pass through the gate and go onto the common.

Once on the common, you can branch off onto any of several longer walks, including the 'Trig Point Walk' (ask us for more details of any of these).

But to continue this short circular walk, continue uphill keeping the fence to your right, then follow the fence round to the right. Cross some narrow valleys and keep going across the common until you come to the crossing of two tracks. Head right and downhill along one of these tracks, you'll come to a gate which leads you into a fairly steep downhill lane. Pass a lane on your left, and keep going downhill until the lane bends to the right and leads you through a farm. Continue through the farm, as you leave it you'll come to the the white "Cefn-Yr-Allt" signpost which you saw when you arrived. Turn right onto the track, as indicated by the sign, then follow it to the right past the two "Cefn-Yr-Allt" mailboxes, and head uphill. Keep going up the track (you drove along this when you arrived) until you come to the Barn Annexe.
